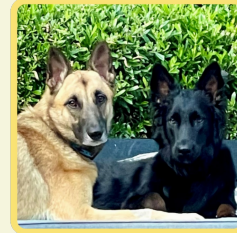




Dear friends and fellow animal lovers,

Chloe adores her new family that came with a human sibling as well as a canine sibling. They are one big happy family. Go, Chloe!!!

And Mochi, our little paralyzed Frenchie finally hit the jackpot and found his forever home. He also became instant shadow to his new brother, Bruno. # Jack

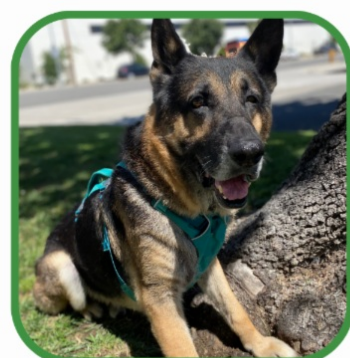
IS READY FOR
